


2025 Green Schools Conference Fact Sheet

The GSC Pass provides access to one half-day workshop, two days of interdisciplinary education, inspirational keynote presentations, networking activities, Exchange Showcase, Speed Greening, the Best of Green Schools Awards Luncheon, and Closing Reception. The 2025 program consists of:

- Impactful education sessions: Join us for an exciting series of one-hour educational sessions designed to empower educators, students, and community members with essential knowledge on pressing issues affecting our environment and society. Our program features a diverse array of topics, including Environmental Justice & Health Equity, Communication for Climate Action, Partnerships for Sustainable & Equitable Schools, Healthy, Zero Energy Schools, and Sustainable School Culture & Climate. Each session is designed to be interactive and informative, providing practical tools and resources to help participants implement positive changes in their communities.
- Inspiring general sessions: Thought-provoking keynote presentations give context to the education provided at the conference and stretch attendees' understanding of how to bring sustainability to life in the classroom. Former keynotes include photographer Matika Wilbur, author Charles Eisenstein, STEM advocate Justin "Mr. Fascinate" Shaifer, educator Chris Emdin, designer and urban agriculture advocate Emmanuel Pratt, Biomimicry expert and pioneer Janine Benyus, world-renowned artist Zaria Forman and ocean advocate and STEM TV series host Danni Washington.
- **Targeted networking and resource sharing:** This year, attendees will have dedicated time with industry experts and resource providers during the Speed Greening and Exchange Showcase where strategies, resources and advice will be shared for reaching attendees sustainability goals. Additionally, during roundtable discussions, audiences will convene to learn, share and network among a diverse group of school leaders ranging from teachers and school leaders to school district facility and sustainability staff, green building professionals, and green school advocates and community partners.

- K-12 school and district attendees and government attendees: \$550 Confidence Pricing, \$575 Early Bird, \$625 Standard or \$700 Onsite
- Employees of USGBC and GSNN Members: \$600 Confidence Pricing, \$650 Early Bird, \$700 Standard or \$775 Onsite
- General: \$650 Confidence Pricing, \$700 Early Bird, \$750 Standard or \$825 Onsite
